This year proved out to be no exception for our college, as our students performed remarkably well in different sports maintaining the status that our college has achieved in past 78 years.

This year, our college had the honour of hosting inter collegiate sports events in association with the Sports Department of the University of Mumbai.

The Women's Volley Ball Tournament was organized between 8th October and 10th October, 2018 on the College playground. Around 96 Colleges affiliated to the University participated in the Tournament.

Further, the college also had the honour of successfully hosting inter-collegiate sports events in association with the District Sports Office, Mumbai City, Sion, Mumbai. The Judo District level tournament was organized between 30th September, 2018 and 1st October, 2018 in our Auditorium. The age groups of under 14 years, 17 years & 19 years (Boys & Girls) had participated in the tournament.

In inter collegiate sports events, over 500 Junior College and Degree College students represented college in different sports activities.

In 2018-19, 8 students played Nationals, 11 students played for State and more than 21 students represented Mumbai University in their respective sports. The junior college students performed exceptionally well in D.S.O tournaments bagging 47 Gold, 49 Silver and 7 Bronze Medals while degree college students secured 21 Gold, 5 Silver and 15 Bronze medals playing for the college.
