In the academic year 2020-2021, 240 students enrolled for the extension work activity. The teacher In-charge and student managers conducted the first term training session under the guidance of the Field Coordinator.

- **Kalaholic** by Pune Vidyarthi Grisham's College of Science and Technology
 - 1st Podium in Shayari reciting competition, doodling competition, mono acting competition, and treasure hunt competition.

Details of projects under DLLE:

- **Career Project (CP)**

The presentations of various careers were to be presented to different schools and a 40 page career project information, a brochure and an interview with the person pursuing the career would be submitted by the students. It would give knowledge to students about opportunities in different careers.
- **Status of Women in Society (SWS)**

Students under SWS are told to take an interview of 40 women and conclude their

experience of the survey, with the attached format of the interview given and a photograph of the interviewee. This would create social awareness in students about the status of women and their problems in society.

- **Population Education Club (PEC)**

The students organized 2 programs at community level and 2 programs at college level and they would write their experiences and learning and submit the same. Here, they learned management skills.

- **Estrade**

This year, for the first time, the department organized an online Intra and inter-college fest 'Estrade' wherein 20 colleges all over Mumbai participated. The fest was for spreading awareness among the community and providing education and knowledge through the activities conducted.
