In the academic year 2022-2023, 387 students were enrolled for the extension work activity. The teachers in-charge and student managers conducted the first term training session under the guidance of the Field Coordinator.

## **Details on DLLE projects:**

### ● **Career Project (CP)**

Each student selected a different career for their project. The students made presentations on various careers and submitted a project report. The students also interviewed people who are already pursuing the same career as they had selected which gave them knowledge about opportunities in different careers.

### ● **Status of Women in Society (SWS)**

Students under SWS project surveyed women, based on the format of the interview which has been given by the University of Mumbai. Each student submitted their projects on time. Each project included surveys of 40 women and 2-3 photographs with women respondents and the student. This project helped create social awareness in students about the status of women and the problems faced by them in society.

### ● **Population Education Club (PEC)**

The students organised 2 programs at community level and 2 programs at college level and submitted a report about their experiences and learning outcome. This project helped them to learn management skills and organisation skills.

### ● **Annapoorna Yojna (APY)**

Cooking and catering are skills needed today for every individual. Also there is a need to learn regular business transactions to earn a profit by selling regular used items such as stationary. Students can also sell healthy food items. This activity has been designed to encourage the student to try their hand at small scale business. Hence this activity is designed to make student skills for Starting a small scale business to become Self-reliant.

### **Activities conducted for the year 2022–23:**

1) Astronomy Workshop (Revealing the secrets of universe)-held from 12th to 17th September 2022 (1 week workshop):-

This activity helped the students to uncover some interesting facts about the universe and to understand the fascinating concepts related to the universe. One of our ex-podarite 'Mr.Archit Gokhale was invited to conduct this workshop.

2) First term training session – held on 19th September 2022: -

All the important details about all four projects were explained to the students. This session helped the students to choose their project and start working on it .

3) Shattering the Disability myth – held on 3rd December 2022: -

In this activity the students had to break the myths that the society had built for the Disabled people. The students could justify the topic by showcasing their talent through photography, dance performance, Paintings, Poems etc.

4) Christmas celebration with poor kids – held on 25th December 2022: -

The volunteers and the student managers of DLLE celebrated Christmas with small poor kids near the Dadar TT area by distributing snacks, telling them stories about Christmas, and spending great time with them.

5) Second term training session -held on 17th and 19th January 2023: -

In this training session students were given a brief idea about each individual project which they have chosen. At the end of the session there was a doubt solving session in which students could clear their doubts if they had any.
