Extra Curricular Credits

R. A. Podar College of Commerce & Economics (Autonomous) organises extracurricular activities for students in addition to the academic curriculum. Students would have to register with the Extra Curricular Credit Committee (ECCC) to earn credits under Extra Curricular Activities (ECA). A student can earn 2 credits per year and a maximum of 6 credits in 3 years through ECA. The purpose of extracurricular activities is primarily the acquisition of skills and competencies in areas that are not directly part of the study programme. The activity hours accumulated throughout the year shall be calculated by the ECCC to fix the number of credits to be granted to students at the end of the year. Thus, a learner can participate in college activities and earn credits.
