This year marked the 81st year of celebration of Ganeshotsav by Podar Ganeshotsav Mandal. It was a one and half day celebration conducted on 10th and 11th of September 2021.

The first day started with the "aagman" of Lord Ganesha wherein the idol of Lord Ganesha was brought in the college auditorium. The aagman was followed by "Pratishthapana Pooja" and Ganesh aarti, after which everyone took the blessings of Ganesha.

The second day started with Ganesh aarti after which all the professors, students and alumni took blessings from the Almighty. This year also marked the presence of Mr. R. R.
