

Rostrum Spectrum:

Rostrum Spectrum is an Inter-Collegiate literary extravaganza and the flagship literary event of the Speakers' Academy and The Group Discussion Cell. The event was conducted on 4th March 2022 on the MS Teams platform starting with the Inauguration ceremony.

'Rostrum' essentially signifies 'Debate' and 'Spectrum' signifies 'Group Discussion' which is how the name came to be. The broad gamut of Rostrum Spectrum comprises 4 events, namely, Debate, Elocution, Group Discussion, and Just-A-Minute (JAM). The theme for Rostrum Spectrum was 'Youth at Cultural Crossroads.' The theme gives a chance to give a thought to all the questions that spark when we think about the Youth standing at Cultural Crossroads.

The event was judged by 3 judges. For Semi-Finals we had Ms. Divya Iyer and Ms. Nikita Tanksali, and for Finals we had Mr. Sunil Shanewar.
